

## Attack plan

One idea is reuse Solar Designer's unlink attack. We cannot use it for the original purpose, since NX is active, but we can use it to overwrite an entry of `objects` that is pointing to an Echo object (and therefore has read permissions) with a pointer to a Secret object, and then read the Secret object.

Luckily the second (unwanted) write of the unlink attack will just overwrite part of the “- SECRET DATA -” header.
